9. Uncle Tom is a very humble man.

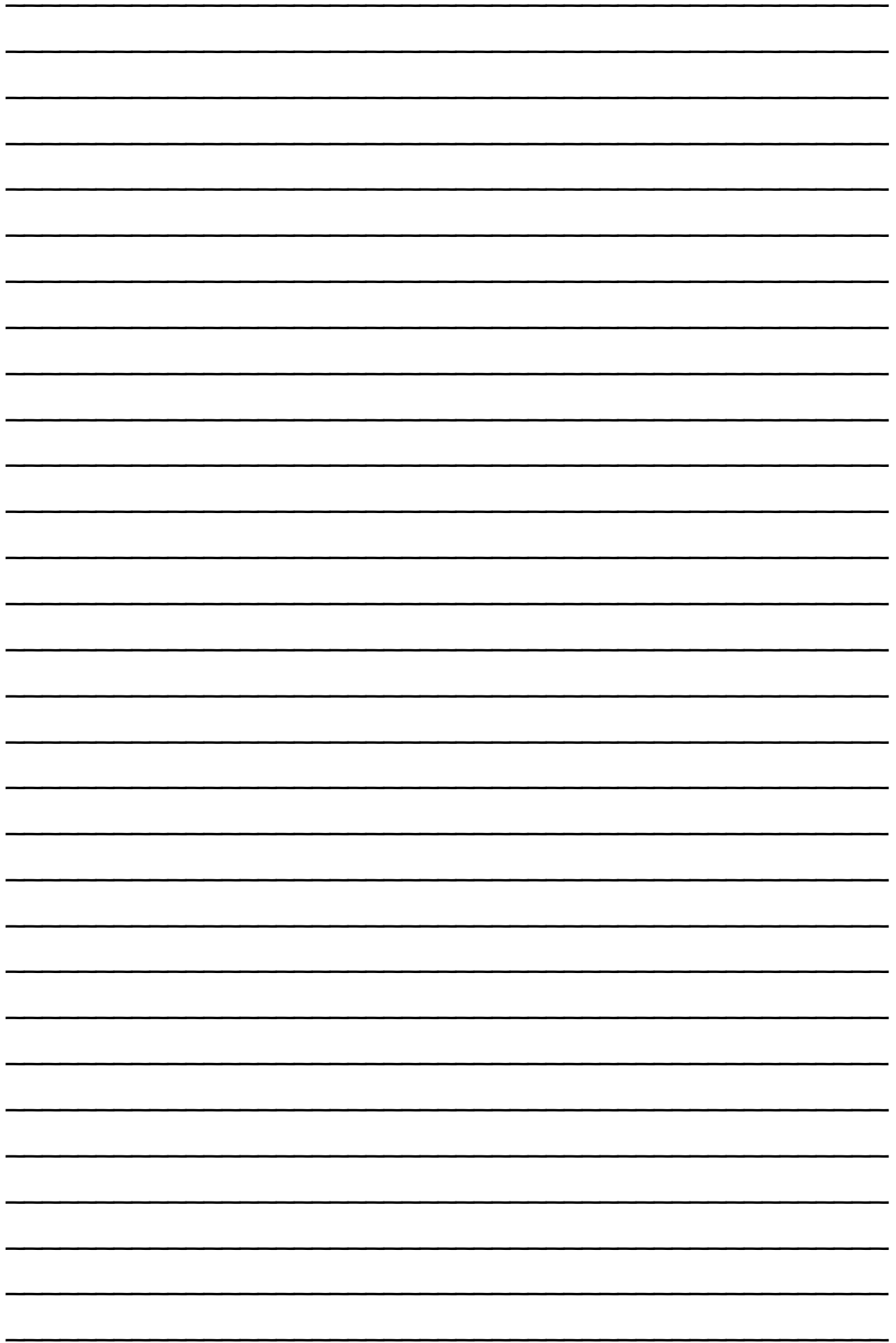
